The first concert is on **Saturday, October 17, 2015** at **8:00 p.m.** and features **Carl Maria von Weber's *Trio for Flute, Cello, and Piano, Op. 63***. **Felix Mendelssohn's *Piano Trio No. 1 in D minor, Op. 49*** concludes the program.

The next concert in the series will be on **Saturday, January 23, 2016** at **8:00 p.m.** and features **Franz Joseph Haydn's *String Quartet in E-Flat, Op. 33, No. 2, "The Joke"*** **Johannes Brahms' *Clarinet Quintet in B minor, Op. 115*** concludes the program.

The final concert in the series will be on **Saturday, February 27, 2016** at **8:00 p.m.** featuring **Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's *Piano Trio in G Major, K. 496***. The program concludes with **Antonin Dvorak's *Piano Trio in E minor, Op. 90, "Dumky."***
